

## ORDINANCE NO. 8

AN ORDINANCE READOPTING THE EXISTING COUNTY CODE: AND AMENDING AND/OR REPEALING CERTAIN PORTIONS THEREIN, BENTON COUNTY, IOWA:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF BENTON COUNTY, IOWA:

SECTION 1. Purpose. Code of Iowa section 331.302, subsection nine, requires that once every five years a County shall compile its code of ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in effect and amends certain ordinances and/or repeals any ordinance deemed no longer necessary to the operation of Benton County, Iowa or to the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens.

SECTION 2. Readoption and Amendment of Current Code. The following ordinances, have been previously adopted and enacted into law and were duly published as the law provides. They are stated herein by number and subject matter and by the authority of the Benton County Board of Supervisors comprise Benton County Code of Ordinances:

1. No. 2 (e.g.) Airport tall structure zoning in its entirety.
2. No. 3 (e.g.) General relief program, in its entirety, except section 6, which was repealed (see ordinance 7)
3. No. 5 (e.g.) Area service system B roads, in its entirety.
4. No. 6 (e.g.) Snow and ice removal level of service, in its entirety.
5. No. 7 (e.g.) Burial Policy procedure of General Relief program, in its entirety. (See ordinance 3)

SECTION 3. Repeal of County Law(s). The following ordinances, deemed by the board of supervisors to be of no further value to the operation of Benton County or to the health, safety and welfare of its citizens, are hereby repealed.

1. No. 1 (e.g.) Ordinance Adoption Procedures Ordinance, in its entirety.
2. No. 4 (e.g.) Amendment Section 3, Ordinance 1 (Ordinance Adoption Procedures)

SECTION 4. Code of Ordinances. Copies of the code as adopted herein shall be on file and available for public inspection in the office of the county auditor and at the following locations: Office of County Attorney.

SECTION 5. When Effective. This ordinance shall be effective after its
