Old business

- a. City of Atkins Atkins Roundhouse: Williams has reached out to the City of Atkins and has not heard back.
- b. One-acre parcels: Williams has told county attorney that this is not a high priority but to keep it in mind.
- c. **Hannen Lake Shop**: Plan to start construction on April 1. Still waiting on bid contracts. Williams will be following up with these remaining companies this week.

- a. TriCounty Snowmobile Association: MOU meeting will be held at the next board meeting.
- b. Wildcat Disc Golf Volunteers: No update.
- c. **Foundation:** Next meeting: Tuesday, April 18, 2023 at 7:00pm. Donation given in Mike Hagen's father's name.
- d. OCNT Committee: Next meeting: Spring 2023. Abstract for the new trailhead has been completed. Next step is title opinion and deed transfer. DOT notified BCCB there will be work on 218 and the current trailhead would be affected. LaGrange will be talking to nearby businesses to discuss donations towards rock for the new trailhead.

Law Enforcement: Spring CCPOA Workshop will be held this week. We will be replacing all of the trail cams in the parks as our current service is being discontinued. Looking at getting new ones through security.

BCCB Properties

- a. Wildcat Bluff Recreation Area: Williams will be speaking with John Tuthill about getting access to the property so BCCB can do inventories and burns. Hill suggested we get in contact with Shellsburg and Urbana to explain the acquisition. Williams plans to go to city meetings to discuss the acquisition. Williams has a piece posted in the newsletter and plans to post in newspapers. BCC plans to hold an informational meeting about the acquisition in early June during Egg-celent Weekend. BCC plans to create larger maps for members to take to different meetings.
- b. Paha: Cecilia Dirks and Parmater have been working on the groundwork for a grant application for improvement work.
- c. **Wells:** Rodgers and Nature Center wells need to be tested and DNR permitted because they are a public water source. The current wells need to be reworked in the future as we cannot have them in the pits. Wildcat wells tests came back good.
